STUDENT RIGHT-TO-KNOW REGULATIONS

The Student Right-to-Know Act (pub.L. 105-18) requires schools to disclose information about graduation rates to current and prospective students and the public. The Student Right-to-Know regulation defines the reporting period to be based on starting September 1st and ending August 31st of each year.

Associated Technical College - San Diego, in complying with the Student Right-to-Know Act will disclose the following graduation rates of its students whom graduated within the required 150% of the normal time for the period of September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2009 for the Telecommunications and the Microcomputer Technology programs.

The School had enrolled one hundred and eighty-eight (188=100%) students in its Telecommunications Program. One hundred and fourteen (114=61%) completed the training and the remaining seventy four (74=39%) either did not graduate or did not complete within the 150% of the normal time.

The School had enrolled twenty four (24=100%) students in its Microcomputer Technology Program. Fifteen (15=63%) completed the training and the remaining nine (9=37%) either did not graduate or did not complete within the 150% of the normal time.
